Text: What is social networking?

Others are appreciated because of online games.

It is important to be aware that any app, site, game or platform that allows communication between users can be used to bully or harass and can

be used by online predators.

3. All social networking sites have age restrictions and it is important for parents to read and understand the site's Terms and Conditions of Use. This is particularly important when the account user is a young person. You don't pick and choose which rules you follow in the real world, so children should not be permitted to access age restricted accounts.
